RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION CE 2-86 BY AUTHORIZING
DESIGNATED EMPLOYEES IN THE TRANSPORTATION DIVISION
TO EXERCISE POWERS OF ARREST AS A PEACE OFFICER TO
ENFORCE SPECIFIC PROVISIONS OF THE PUBLIC UTILITIES CODE

WHEREAS: Resolution CE 2-86, CE 8-86, and CE 12-86 authorize designated employees in the Transportation Division who have completed the prescribed training course, pursuant to Penal Code Sections 832 and 830.7, relating to exercising the powers of arrest of a peace officer, and to enforce specified categories of criminal offenses relating to the Public Utilities Code; and

WHEREAS: Mark Clairmont and Curtis Jung, investigators, assigned to the Special Investigations Unit, Compliance and Enforcement Branch, Transportation Division, have successfully completed on October 4, 1991, the mandatory training, pursuant to Penal Code Section 832, at the Criminal Justice Training Center, Modesto Junior College, Modesto, California;


THEREFORE: IT IS ORDERED that,

Mark Clairmont and Curtis Jung are hereby authorized to exercise the powers of a peace officer, pursuant to Penal Code Section 830.7 to enforce the provisions of the Public Utilities Code.
