

R E S O L U T I O N

RESOLUTION EXTENDING INVITATION TO THE NATIONAL
CONFERENCE OF STATE TRANSPORTATION SPECIALISTS TO HOLD
ITS 1989 ANNUAL MEETING IN SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA

WHEREAS: The National Conference of State Transportation Specialists, formed in 1959, is an organization composed of State and Federal agencies exercising economic jurisdiction over all modes of surface transportation; and

WHEREAS: The National Conference of State Transportation Specialists is an affiliate of the National Association of Regulatory Utility Commissioners; and

WHEREAS: The staff members of this Commission's Transportation Division have actively participated in the Conference, with a member having served as its President, another member having been elected to the Executive Committee for the last eight years consecutively, and other members having been appointed to serve, from time to time, on various sub-committees; and

WHEREAS: This Commission last hosted the National Conference of State Transportation Specialists' annual meeting that was held in San Francisco in 1972; and

WHEREAS: The Site Committee of the National Conference of State Transportation Specialists has expressed an interest in coming back to California;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA cordially extends its invitation to the National Conference of State Transportation Specialists to hold its 1989 Annual Meeting in June in San Diego, California.
