RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING LATE-FILED ACCEPTANCE OF CERTIFICATE REVISION GRANTED BY RESOLUTION PE-2332 TO MARIN AIRPORTER

Resolution PE-2332, dated August 6, 1986, authorized Narin Airporter, a passenger stage corporation, to add an additional passenger pickup and discharge point at the Novato Travelodge, 7600 Redwood Highway, in Novato. It recently came to the staff's attention that Narin Airporter did not file a written acceptance within thirty days of the date of the resolution as required by paragraph one of the resolution, nor did the carrier file tariffs reflecting the route revision authorized as required by paragraph two of the resolution. The carrier did file amended timetables, however, as part of another action.

When brought to the carrier's attention, the carrier stated that it had never received a copy of Resolution PE-2332 and therefore had not been aware of such requirements. Since the carrier had not heard to the contrary, it had assumed that everything was in order and that it could serve the new point. Since this matter was brought to the carrier's attention, it now wishes to comply. Because it has been serving this point since the filing of its timetables effective August 18, 1986, it requests that this matter be handled expeditiously.

Under the circumstances, the Commission finds that Marin Airporter's late-filed acceptance and tariff filings should be accepted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

The late-filed acceptance of the route revision granted to Marin Airporter in Resolution PE-2332 and the related tariff filings are hereby accepted.

This resolution is effective today.
