(RESOLUTION SUSPENDING AND REVOKING THE HIGHWAY CONTRACT) (CARRIER PERMIT OF BRIAN E. OAKLEY AND DENISE M. OAKLEY, ) (DOING BUSINESS AS UKIAH TIMBER PRODUCTS FOR FAILURE TO) (PRODUCE RECORDS FOR EXAMINATION)

Brian E. Oakley and Denise N. Oakley, a partnership doing business as Ukiah Timber Products (T-139,597), 4300 North State Street, Ukiah, CA 95482, hold a highway contract carrier permit issued by this Commission.

By letters dated January 27, 1986 and April 24, 1986, pursuant to Sections 3705 and 3706 of the Public Utilities Code, this carrier was informed that the Commission's Transportation Division desired to examine their transportation records for the purpose of determining compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations. The carrier was requested to produce certain specified records covering the period April 1, 1985 through December 31, 1985 at the carrier's office located at 4300 North State Street in Ukiah on May 5, 1986 at 1:00 P.M.

The carrier did not produce its records in response to the staff's requests. Several prior attempts to examine this carrier's records were also disregarded. The carrier has made no subsequent attempt to comply with the staff's request to furnish its records for examination.

The Commission finds that Brian E. Oakley and Denise H. Oakley, doing business as Ukiah Timber Products, have failed to produce the records pertaining to their operations as a highway carrier after sufficient requests have been made upon them pursuant to Sections 3705 and 3706 of the Public Utilities Code. The Commission concludes that their highway contract carrier permit should be suspended and revoked unless the records are produced for examination.

## 17 IS ORDERED that:

The highway contract carrier permit issued to Brian E. Oakley and Denise M. Oakley, doing business as Ukiah Timber Products, is suspended thirty days after the effective date of this order and shall be revoked thirty days after the date of suspension, unless prior to the dates of suspension and revocation the carrier produces the records specified below for examination in the Commission's office located at 50 "D" Street, Suite 455, Santa Rosa, CA 95404 (telephone (707) 576-2170), at a mutually agreed upon time.

The carrier shall produce all freight bills, bills of lading, contracts, weighmaster certificates, dispatch records, books of account, cancelled checks, check registers, and any other supporting documents covering the period from April 1, 1985 to June 1, 1987. Should Brian E. Oakley and Denise H. Oakley desire to protest this action, a formal application requesting a hearing must be filed in accordance with the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure. Such application will stay the revocation of carrier's operating authority.

The Executive Director is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this resolution on Brian E. Oakley or Denise M. Oakley.

The effective date of this order is the date of service upon the carrier.
