RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ADDITIONAL DESIGNATED EMPLOYEES IN THE
TRANSPORTATION DIVISION TO EXERCISE POWERS OF ARREST OF A PEACE OFFICER
TO ENFORCE MISDEMEANOR OFFENSES UNDER THE PUBLIC UTILITIES CODE

WHEREAS: Section 830.7 of the Penal Code (P.C.) authorizes employees in the Transportation Division designated by the Director of Transportation to exercise powers of arrest of a peace officer limited to the enforcement of the misdemeanor provisions of the Public Utilities Code upon completion of training prescribed by 832 P.C., and upon approval of the Commission; and

WHEREAS: The Commission, by Resolution CE 2-86, dated March 5, 1986, adopted departmental policy which sets forth the scope and extent to which powers of arrest may be exercised by designated employees; and

WHEREAS: The employees named in Appendix A, assigned to the Compliance and Enforcement Branch, Transportation Division, successfully completed in June, 1986 the training course prescribed by the Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training at the Northern California Criminal Justice Training and Education System, Sacramento Center;

THEREFORE: IT IS ORDERED that:

The employees listed in Appendix A are hereby authorized to exercise the powers of arrest of a peace officer to the extent provided in Resolution CE 2-86 to enforce the misdemeanor provisions of the P.U. Code.
