RESOLUTION

(RESOLUTION SUSPENDING AND REVOKING THE OPERATING (AUTHORITY OF G.O.T. LINES, INC. FOR FAILURE TO COMPLY (WITH CITATION FORFEITURE NO. F-2877.

WHEREAS, On December 20, 1985 G.O.T. LINES, INC. was served with Citation Forfeiture No. F-2877; and

WHEREAS, The carrier agreed in writing not to contest the citation and to pay the fine of \$1,500 imposed by Citation Forfeiture No. F-2877 in installments of \$200 each. Payments were to be made the 15th of the month, commencing May 15, 1990.

WHEREAS, The carrier made two payments of \$200 toward the fine, one in May and one in September 1990 but has failed to make any further payments;

IT IS RESOLVED THAT:

- 1. The operating authority of the above named carrier is suspended for a period of 30 days, or until the \$1,100 balance of the citation forfeiture is paid. The carrier may not operate during suspension.
- 2. If by the end of the 30 day period the carrier has not complied with the terms of the citation nor filed for a hearing, then the operating authority of the above named carrier will be automatically revoked.
- 3. Filing of a request for hearing will stay the revocation of the operating authority, but the suspension will remain in force. The carrier may not operate.

4. During a hearing, the burden of proof will be on the carrier to show why the revocation should not take place.
