R E S O L U T I O N

SUSPENDING AND REVOKING THE OPERATING AUTHORITY OF  
RUSSELL L. DILLON, DOING BUSINESS AS DILLON AND  
SONS TRUCKING, OROVILLE, FOR FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH  
THE TERMS OF A CITATION.

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WHEREAS, on February 15, 1991, the Transportation Division served the carrier with Citation Forfeiture No. F-4236, for the amount of \$500; and

WHEREAS, on February 15, 1991, the carrier agreed to comply with said citation forfeiture but indicated it was not immediately able to do so; and

WHEREAS, on April 18, 1991, the carrier proposed to pay the \$500 in monthly installments of \$100 beginning May 15, 1991;

WHEREAS, on April 25, 1991, the Transportation Division prepared and sent to the carrier a formal agreement reflecting the terms of the carrier's proposal; and

WHEREAS, on May 23, 1991, the carrier accepted the formal agreement, with the understanding that non-compliance could result in the suspension and revocation of its operating authority, and submitted a partial payment of \$100 leaving an unpaid balance of \$400; and

WHEREAS, on October 21, 1991, the Transportation Division received a partial payment of \$200, leaving an unpaid balance of \$200; and

WHEREAS, on October 28, 1991, the Transportation Division agreed to the carrier's proposal to pay the \$200 balance in \$100 payments on November 15, 1991, and December 15, 1991; and

WHEREAS, on February 20, 1992, the Transportation Division, having received no payments toward the \$200 balance, notified the carrier that failure to comply with the terms of the agreement would subject its operating authority to suspension and revocation, pursuant to the provisions of Resolution L-228; and

WHEREAS, the carrier's failure to comply with the terms of the citation forfeiture, as amended, continues;

IT IS RESOLVED THAT:

1. The operating authority of the above-named carrier is suspended for a period of 30 days, or until the full amount of the citation forfeiture is paid, during which time the carrier may not operate.

2. If by the end of the 30 day period the carrier has neither complied with the terms of the citation nor requested a hearing, the operating authority of the above-named carrier will be automatically revoked.

3. Although a request for hearing will stay the revocation of the operating authority, absent full payment of the amount of the citation forfeiture the suspension will remain in force and the carrier may not operate.

4. During the hearing, the carrier will have the burden of showing why its authority should not be revoked.


