RESOLUTION

ORDER ESTABLISHING 1986 UNDERGROUND CONVERSION BUDGET FOR SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY

Southern California Edison Company (SCE) in its compliance letter dated March 12, 1986, in accordance with Ordering Paragraph 6 of Decision No. 73078 in Case 8209, requests approval for an underground conversion budget for 1986 of \$25,500,000.

SCE's approved budget for 1985 was also \$25,500,000. In its prior submittal of June 7, 1985, SCE had proposed an amount of \$28,000,000 for 1986 under a 5-year program. This increased amount was proposed to encourage the underground conversion program in conformance with Commission's policy. In view of the above and the substantial interest shown by the cities in utility's service area for the expansion of the program, the Service and Safety Branch of the Evaluation and Compliance Division has proposed that a 1986 budget allocation of \$28,000,000 be ordered by the Commission.

In compliance with Ordering Paragraph No. 1 of Decision No. 82-01-018, SCE shall allocate its conversion budget in the ratio of overhead served meters in a city or unincorporated area to the SCE system's total overhead served meters.

It is found that there is a continuing need for conversion of overhead electric and communication facilities to underground.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

SCE shall budget \$28.000,000 for its 1986 underground conversion program.
