#### RESOLUTION

SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY (EDISON) AUTHORIZATION TO IMPLEMENT A REFUND PLAN IN THE AMOUNT OF \$36,000 INCLUDING APPROPRIATE INTEREST, FOR ELECTRIC CUSTOMERS ON SANTA CATALINA ISLAND

By letter dated May 22, 1986, Edison has submitted a plan to refund to active electric customers on Santa Catalina Island ("Catalina") during the August 1986 billing period, an estimated overcollected balance of \$36,000, including accrued interest, in the Catalina Energy Cost Balance Adjustment Account. The facts are as follows:

- On April 4, 1985, Edison filed Advice Letter No. 674-E réquesting the élimination of the Catalina Energy Cost Balance Adjustment ("CECBA") from Part G of thé Préliminary Statement as of May 1, 1985. Edison's réquest was granted on May 1, 1985.
- 2. While the Catalina Energy Cost Balance Adjustment Billing Factor ("CECBABF") surcharge ended on May 1, 1985, the CEC Balancing Account has remained active in order to accumulate any billing adjustments and accrued interest since May 1, 1985. The account has since accrued an overcollected balance that is estimated to total \$36,000, including interest, to September 1, 1986.
- 3. The interest rate is compounded monthly at the rate of 1/12 of the interest rate on Commercial Paper.

4. All active Catalina electric customers will receive refunds during the August 1986 billing period based upon the estimated CECBA balance of \$36,000, including accrued interest to September 1, 1986. The average domestic customer will receive a refund of approximately \$7.74.

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5. The refund amount per electric customers will be computed based upon:

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 kWh usage by rate schedule for the 12 months ending April 30, 1986, and

The number of active electric customers per rate schedule during August 1986. Refunds will be crédited to customer bills às follows:

- (1) The amount of the refund shall be allocated to each Catalina electric rate schedule in proportion to the total kWh usage for each rate schedule during the 12 months ending April 30, 1986. The refund amount per rate schedule shall be divided by the active Catalina electric customers of record per rate schedule as provided in attachment "A". The result shall be the refund amount per active Catalina electric customer, which will be credited to active Catalina electric customers' bills during the August 1986 billing period. See attachment "A".
- (2) Réfunds will bé madé only to activé Catalina eléctric customers of récord during the August 1986 billing period. Refund réquests from former customers will be considered on a casé-by-casé basis.
- (3) A méssagé on the August 1986 électric bill of activé Catalina éléctric customer's bills will éxplain the purposé of the réfund.
- (4) Réfund àmounts to éach éligible Edison émployée will bé réduced by 25 percent to adjust for the émployée discount.
- 6. Thé rémaining balance in the CÉCBA as of Décember 31, 1986, will be handled in à manner consistent with <u>Cory</u> <u>vs CPUC</u> 33c.3d 522 (1983).
- 7. Edison will publish notice of the refund in local newspapers on Catalina. Because of the small amount of the refund and the limited number of customers affected, the staff considers this notice to be sufficient.
- Edison will consider and evaluate all inquiries from active customers and former customers through November 30, 1986, and adjustments will be made where deemed appropriate.

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## FINDINGS

1. This refund plan is similar to prior refund plans filed by other California utilities which have been approved by previous Commission resolutions.

2. We find that this refund plan is just and reasonable and in the best interest of the customers and should be implemented in an expeditious manner.

#### THEREFORE:

- 1. Southern California Edison Company is ordered under Section 453.5 of the Public Utilities Code to implement the proposed refund plan as provided above, for refunds to Catalina Island customers during its August 1986 billing cycle.
- Southern California Edison Company shall make reasonable efforts to locate former customers in accordance with the above.
- 3. Edison shall kéep récords of the refunds and shall submit réports to the Commission on the disposition of any amount unrefunded by Décémber 31, 1986. These réports shall include spècific data as to the résults of éfforts to locate former customèrs.
- 4. Southern California Edison Company shall give public notice to its customers of this refund in accordance with its method outlined above.
- 5. This électric réfund plàn shall bé marked to show that it was approved for filing and implémentation by Commission Résolution E-3003. This résolution is éffective today.
