ORDER ESTABLISHING 1987 UNDERGROUND CONVERSION BUDGET FOR PACIFIC GAS AND RECTRIC COMPANY

Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) in its compliance letter dated January 20, 1987, in accordance with Ordering Paragraph 6 of Decision No. 73078 in Case No. 8209, requests approval of its underground conversion budget for 1987 in the amount of \$38,000,000. This includes a special allocation of \$2,000,000 in accordance with Ordering Paragraph 3 of Decision No. 82-12-069.

By letter dated January 20, 1987, in accordance with Decision Nos. 82-12-069 and 83-02-065, the League of California Cities and PG&E have negotiated the above proposed budget for 1987.

In compliance with Ordering Paragraph No. 1 of Decision No. 82-01-018. FG&E has allocated its budget in the ratio of overhead served meters in each city and the unincorporated area of each county to its system's total overhead served meters.

It is found that there is a continuing need for conversion of overhead electric and communication facilities to underground.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

FG&E shall budget \$38.000.000 for its 1987 underground conversion program.
