R E S O L U T I O N

ORDER ESTABLISHING 1987 UNDERGROUND CONVERSION
BUDGET FOR SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY

Southern California Edison Company (SCE) in its compliance letter dated February 9, 1987, in accordance with Ordering Paragraph 6 of Decision No. 73078 in Case 8209, requests approval for an underground conversion budget for 1987 of \$30,000,000.

SCE's approved budget for 1986 was \$28,000,000. SCE has proposed an amount of \$30,000,000 for 1987 under a 5-year program. This increased amount is proposed to encourage the underground conversion program in conformance with Commission's policy. It also takes into consideration the substantial interest shown by the cities in utility's service area for the expansion of the program.

In compliance with Ordering Paragraph No. 1 of Decision No. 82-01-018, SCE shall allocate its conversion budget in the ratio of overhead served meters in a city or unincorporated area to the SCE system's total overhead served meters.

It is found that there is a continuing need for conversion of overhead electric and communication facilities to underground.

IT IS ORDERED that:

SCE shall budget \$30,000,000 for its 1987 underground conversion program.
