R E S O L U T I O N

GRANTING AN EXEMPTION FROM GENERAL ORDER 72-B TO PERMIT THE INSTALLATION OF A RUBBER GRADE CROSSING SURFACE AT THE STATE COLLEGE BOULEVARD CROSSING OF THE ATCHISON, TOPEKA AND SANTA FE RAILWAY COMPANY'S TRACKS, CROSSING 2-170.3, IN ANAHEIM, ORANGE COUNTY.

The City of Anaheim (City) by letter dated August 8, 1986, has requested that it be granted an exemption from General Order 72-B to permit the installation of a rubber grade crossing surface at the State College Boulevard crossing of the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company's (AT&SF) tracks, Crossing 2-170.3, in Anaheim, Orange County. Installation of the rubber grade crossing surface will improve the durability and riding quality of the crossing.

IT IS RESOLVED that the City of Anaheim is granted an exemption from General Order 72-B to permit the installation of a rubber grade crossing surface at the State College Boulevard crossing of the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company's tracks, Crossing 2-170.3, in Anaheim, Orange County.
