RESOLUTION

GRANTING AN EXEMPTION FROM GENERAL ORDER 72-B TO PERMIT THE INSTALLATION OF A RUBBER GRADE CROSSING SURFACE AT THE STATS COLLEGE BOULEVARD CROSSING OF SOUTHERN PACIFIC TRANSPORTATION COMPANY'S TRACKS, CROSSING BM-512.7 IN ANAHEIM, ORANGE COUNTY.
