R E S O L U T I O N

GRANTING AN EXEMPTION FROM GENERAL ORDER 72-B TO PERMIT THE INSTALLATION OF A RUBBER GRADE CROSSING SURFACE AT THE ARCHIBALD AVENUE CROSSING OF THE ATCHISON, TOPEKA AND SANTA FE RAILWAY COMPANY'S TRACKS, CROSSING 2-97.7, IN RANCHO CUCAMONGA, SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY.

The City of Rancho Cucamonga (City), by letter dated September 12, 1986, has requested that it be granted an exemption from General Order 72-B to permit the installation of a rubber grade crossing surface, at the Archibald Avenue crossing of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company's (AT&SF) tracks, Crossing 2-97.7, in Rancho Cucamonga, San Bernardino County.

Under cover of September 30, 1986, the Commission staff authorized City to improve Archibald Avenue as provided in General Order 88-A. To improve the durability and riding quality of the improved crossing, City has requested an exemption from General Order 72-B to permit installation of a rubber grade crossing surface.

IT IS RESOLVED that the City of Rancho Cucamonga is granted an exemption from General Order 72-B to permit the installation of a rubber grade crossing surface at the Archibald Avenue crossing of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company's tracks, Crossing 2-97.7, in Rancho Cucamonga, San Bernardino County.

This resolution is effective today.
