R E S O L U T I O N

GRANTING AN EXEMPTION FROM GENERAL ORDER 72-B TO PERMIT THE INSTALLATION OF A RUBBER GRADE CROSSING SURFACE AT THE 182ND STREET CROSSING OF THE ATCHISON, TOPEKA AND SANTA FE RAILWAY COMPANY'S TRACKS, CROSSING 2H-18.4 IN REDONDO BEACH AND TORRANCE, LOS ANGELES COUNTY.

The City of Redondo Beach, also acting in behalf of the City of Torrance, by letter dated October 9, 1986, has requested that they be granted an exemption from General Order 72-B to permit the installation of a rubber grade crossing surface at the 182nd Street crossing of the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company's (AT&SF) tracks, Crossing 2H-18.4, in Redondo Beach and Torrance, Los Angeles County. Installation of the rubber grade crossing surface will improve the durability and riding quality of the crossing.

IT IS RESOLVED that the Cities of Redondo Beach and Torrance be granted an exemption from General Order 72-B to permit the installation of a rubber grade crossing surface at the 182nd Street crossing of the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company's tracks, Crossing 2H-18.4, in Redondo Beach and Torrance, Los Angeles County.

This resolution is effective today.
