R E S O L U T I O N

GRANTING AN EXEMPTION FROM GENERAL ORDER 72-B TO PERMIT THE INSTALLATION OF A RUBBER GRADE CROSSING SURFACE AT TWO CROSSINGS OF ATLANTIC BOULEVARD, 25B-1.43-C AND 25C-1.46-C, ACROSS THE LOS ANGELES JUNCTION RAILWAY COMPANY'S TRACKS IN BELL, LOS ANGELES COUNTY.

The City of Bell, by letter dated October 15, 1986, has requested that it be granted an exemption from General Order 72-B to permit the installation of rubber grade crossing surface at two crossings of Atlantic Boulevard, 25B-1.43-C and 25C-1.46C, across the Los Angeles Junction Railway Company's tracks in Bell, Los Angeles County. Installation of the rubber grade crossing surface will improve the durability and riding quality of the crossing.

IT IS RESOLVED that the City of Bell is granted an exemption from General Order 72-B to permit the installation of a rubber grade crossing surface at the two crossings of Los Angeles Junction Railway Company's tracks at Atlantic Boulevard, 25B-1.43-C and 25C-1.46-C, in Bell, Los Angeles County.
