R E S O L U T I O N

GRANTING AN EXEMPTION FROM GENERAL ORDER 72-B TO PERMIT THE INSTALLATION OF A RUBBER GRADE CROSSING SURFACE AT TWO CROSSINGS, FLORENCE AVENUE (BKA-499.0) AND PIONEER BOULEVARD (BKA-499.1) OF SOUTHERN PACIFIC TRANSPORTATION COMPANY'S TRACKS IN SANTA FE SPRINGS, LOS ANGELES COUNTY.


The City of Santa Fe Springs, by letter dated October 16, 1986, has requested that it be granted an exemption from General Order 72-B to permit the installation of rubber grade crossing surface at two crossings, Florence Avenue (BKA-499.0) and Pioneer Boulevard (BKA-499.1) of Southern Pacific Transportation Company's tracks in Santa Fe Springs, Los Angeles County. Installation of the rubber grade crossing surface will improve the durability and riding quality of the crossing.

IT IS RESOLVED that the City of Santa Fe Springs is granted an exemption from General Order 72-B to permit the installation of a rubber grade crossing surface at the two crossings of Southern Pacific Transportation Company's tracks, Florence Avenue, BKA-499.0, and Pioneer Boulevard, BKA-499.1, in Santa Fe Springs, Los Angeles County.

This resolution is effective today.
