R E S O L U T I O N

GRANTING AN EXEMPTION FROM GENERAL ORDER 72-B TO PERMIT THE INSTALLATION OF RUBBER GRADE CROSSING SURFACES AT FOUR CROSSINGS, LA VETA AVENUE (2-173.3), CHAPMAN AVENUE (2-172.7), PALM AVENUE (2-172.5), AND COLLINS AVENUE (2N-4.9) OF THE ATCHISON, TOPEKA AND SANTA FE RAILWAY COMPANY'S TRACKS IN ORANGE, ORANGE COUNTY.


The City of Orange, by letter dated December 1, 1986, has requested that it be granted an exemption from General Order 72-B to permit the installation of rubber grade crossing surfaces at four crossings, La Veta Avenue (2-173.3), Chapman Avenue (2-172.7), Palm Avenue (2-172.5), and Collins Avenue (2N-4.9) of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company's tracks in Orange, Orange County. Installation of the rubber grade crossing surfaces will improve the durability and riding quality of the crossing.

IT IS RESOLVED that the City of Orange is granted an exemption from General Order 72-B to permit the installation of rubber grade crossing surfaces at the four crossings of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company's tracks, La Veta Avenue (2-173.3), Chapman Avenue (2-172.7), Palm Avenue (2-172.5), and Collins Avenue (2N-4.9), in Orange, Orange County.

This resolution is effective today.
