R E S O L U T I O N

GRANTING AN EXEMPTION FROM GENERAL ORDER 72-B TO PERMIT  
THE INSTALLATION OF A RUBBER GRADE CROSSING SURFACE AT  
THE BENSON AVENUE CROSSING OF THE ATCHISON, TOPEKA AND  
SANTA FE RAILWAY COMPANY'S TRACKS, CROSSING 2-102.7,  
IN UPLAND, SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY.

The City of Upland by letter dated March 24, 1987, has requested that it be granted an exemption from General Order 72-B to permit the installation of a rubber grade crossing surface at the Benson Avenue crossing of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company's tracks, Crossing 2-102.7, in Upland, San Bernardino County. Installation of the rubber grade crossing surface will improve the durability and riding quality of the crossing.

IT IS RESOLVED that the City of Upland is granted an exemption from General Order 72-B to permit the installation of a rubber grade crossing surface at the Benson Avenue crossing of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company's tracks, Crossing 2-102.7, in Upland, San Bernardino County.
