R E S O L U T I O N

GRANTING AN EXEMPTION FROM GENERAL ORDER 72-B TO PERMIT THE INSTALLATION OF RUBBER GRADE CROSSING SURFACES AT TWO CROSSINGS, ORANGE STREET (2U-8.8) AND SIXTH STREET (2U-9.0) OF THE ATCHISON, TOPEKA AND SANTA FE RAILWAY COMPANY'S TRACKS IN REDLANDS, SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY.

The City of Redlands, by letter dated April 8, 1987, has requested that it be granted an exemption from General Order 72-B to permit the installation of rubber grade crossing surfaces at two crossings, Orange Street (2U-8.8) and Sixth Street (2U-9.0) of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company's tracks in Redlands, San Bernardino County. Installation of the rubber grade crossing surfaces will improve the durability and riding quality of the crossings.

IT IS RESOLVED that the City of Redlands is granted an exemption from General Order 72-B to permit the installation of rubber grade crossing surfaces at the two crossings of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company's tracks, Orange Street (2U-8.8) and Sixth Street (2U-9.0) in Redlands, San Bernardino County.
