R E S O L U T I O N

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DOWNGRADING OF CROSSING PROTECTION AT THREE CROSSINGS OF THE RAMPS OF STATE ROUTE 101 ACROSS THE TRACKS OF SOUTHERN PACIFIC TRANSPORTATION COMPANY, FROM STANDARD NO. 8 FLASHING LIGHT SIGNALS TO STANDARD NO. 1-R CROSSING SIGNS AND FLAGGING, NEAR CAMP ROBERTS, SAN LUIS OBISPO COUNTY

The Southern Pacific Transportation Company serves the California Army National Guard, Camp Roberts, San Luis Obispo County, by spur track. The track traverses at grade across the ramps of State Route 101. The crossings are known as Northbound On-Ramp (Crossing E-205.11-C), Northbound On-Ramp (Crossing E-205.12-C) and Southbound Off-Ramp (Crossing E-205.18-C). The Commission's Decision 66203, dated October 22, 1963, authorized the crossings and required installation of one Standard No. 8 flashing light signal warning device at each of the above listed crossings.

The crossings were temporarily out of service for a period of time and the warning devices were removed, but a Form "G" was not filed to remove the crossings from our active crossing files.

The California Army National Guard desires to re-open the track serving the Main Garrison of Camp Roberts and re-activate the crossings. Long term rail activity is expected to be very infrequent, probably not exceeding two trains per year. It is estimated that 90 percent of the roadway traffic is military traffic.

By letter dated July 16, 1987, Southern Pacific Transportation Company has requested authority to downgrade crossing protection, dispense with the need to reinstall Standard No. 8 flashing light signals and to permit flagmen to provide traffic control during rail movements at these crossings.

IT IS RESOLVED that Southern Pacific Transportation Company is granted permission to downgrade crossing protection from Standard No. 8 flashing light signals to Standard No. 1-R crossing signs and flagging at three ramp crossings of State Route 101, Crossings E-205.11-C, E-205.12-C, and E-205.18-C near Camp Roberts, San Luis Obispo County.
