**R E S O L U T I O N**

**RESOLUTION GRANTING EXEMPTION FROM THE MANDATORY STOP  
REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 22452 AND 22452.5 OF THE CALIFORNIA  
VEHICLE CODE TO A CERTAIN RAILROAD-HIGHWAY GRADE CROSSING IN  
THE COUNTY OF VENTURA**

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) has requested authority for exemption from the mandatory stop requirements of Section 22452 and 22452.5 of the California Vehicle Code in accordance with the Commission's General Order No. 145. The following railroad-highway grade crossing of the Southern Pacific Transportation Company is that for which "EXEMPT" status is requested:

State Route No. 126	BE-419.4

The Commission staff, together with all interested parties, investigated Caltrans' request and has concluded that the above named railroad-highway grade crossing complies with the requirements of General Order No. 145 for "EXEMPT" status and that the public interest would be served by its exemption. The Department of California Highway Patrol concurs.


IT IS RESOLVED that "EXEMPT" status for the above named railroad-highway grade crossing is approved.
