R E S O L U T I O N

GRANTING AN EXEMPTION FROM GENERAL ORDER 72-B TO PERMIT THE INSTALLATION OF A RUBBER GRADE CROSSING SURFACE AT WARNER AVENUE CROSSING OF THE ATCHISON, TOPEKA AND SANTA FE RAILWAY COMPANY'S TRACKS, CROSSING 2-178.8-C IN SANTA ANA, ORANGE COUNTY.

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, by letter dated August 12, 1987, has requested that it be granted an exemption from General Order 72-B to permit the installation of a rubber grade crossing surface at the Warner Avenue Crossing of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company's tracks, Crossing 2- 178.8-C in Santa Ana, Orange County. Installation of the rubber grade crossing surface will improve the durability and riding quality of the crossing.

IT IS RESOLVED that The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is granted an exemption from General Order 72-B to permit the installation of a rubber grade crossing surface at the Orange Avenue crossing of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company's tracks, Crossing 2-178.8-C in Santa Ana, Orange County.
