
R E S O L U T I O N

GRANTING AN EXEMPTION FROM GENERAL ORDER 72-B TO PERMIT THE INSTALLATION OF A RUBBER GRADE CROSSING SURFACE AT PARAMOUNT BOULEVARD (AT ROSECRANS AVENUE) CROSSING OF THE SOUTHERN PACIFIC TRANSPORTATION COMPANY'S TRACKS, CROSSING BBL-496.19 IN PARAMOUNT, LOS ANGELES COUNTY.

The City of Paramount by letter dated October 3, 1988, has requested that it be granted an exemption from General Order 72-B to permit the installation of a rubber grade crossing surface at Paramount Boulevard (at Rosecrans Avenue) crossing of the Southern Pacific Transportation Company's (SPT) tracks, Crossing BBL-496.19 in Paramount, Los Angeles County. Installation of the rubber grade crossing surface will improve the durability and riding quality of the crossing.

IT IS RESOLVED that the City of Paramount is granted an exemption from General Order 72-B to permit the installation of a rubber grade crossing surface at Paramount Boulevard (at Rosecrans Avenue) crossing of the Southern Pacific Transportation Company's tracks, Crossing BBL-496.19 in Paramount, Los Angeles County.
