R E S O L U T I O N

GRANTING AN EXEMPTION FROM GENERAL ORDER 72-B TO PERMIT THE INSTALLATION OF RUBBER GRADE CROSSING SURFACES AT TWENTY SIX CROSSINGS OF THE ATCHISON, TOPEKA AND SANTA FE RAILWAY COMPANY'S TRACKS IN VARIOUS CITIES OF ORANGE AND SAN DIEGO COUNTIES.

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, by letter dated October 26, 1988 has requested that it be granted an exemption from General Order 72-B to permit the installation of rubber grade surfaces at twenty six of its crossings listed below in Orange and San Diego Counties:
