R E S O L U T I O N

RESOLUTION SETTING FORTH COMMISSION POLICY FOR
THE DEVELOPMENT OF A TRUCK ACCIDENT FOLLOW-UP
REPORT FOR MOTOR CARRIERS OPERATING ON CALIFORNIA
HIGHWAYS

WHEREAS: There is a need to provide a basis for an in-depth analysis of the causes of truck accidents on California highways; and


WHEREAS: Information collected at the scene of an accident does not contain sufficient data to develop statistics necessary to determine whether there is a causal linkage between industry economic conditions, economic regulatory actions and motor carrier accidents; and

WHEREAS: Motor carrier safety problems should be recognized and highlighted to the extent that the Commission can study and suggest corrective action in a timely manner; and

WHEREAS: An accident follow-up report program, administered by this Commission or some other responsible agency, could provide a comprehensive base for improved safety data;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That, it is the policy of this Commission to support the development of a truck accident follow-up report for the purpose of collecting sufficient data for an in-depth analysis of the causes of truck accidents on California highways. This Commission (1) stands ready to provide active assistance to other responsible agencies developing relevant information on this important matter and, (2) directs its Transportation Division staff to develop and present to the Commission an action plan for the implementation of such a program for California intrastate for-hire carriers. It is the further policy of this Commission that data derived from reports submitted by highway carriers subject to its jurisdiction shall be considered confidential and used only for purposes of program analysis.
