RESOLUTION

SOUTHFRN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY (Socal Gas) ORDER AUTHORIZING A MODIFICATION OF THE FIRST AMENDMENT OF THE WHOLESALE GAS SERVICE AGREEMENT BETWEEN Socal Gas AND SAN DIEGO GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY

SUMMARY:

By Advicé Letter No. 1605, filed February 28, 1986, SoCal Gas has requested a modification to the Gas Service Agreement, which provides for wholesale service to San Diego Gas & Electric Company (SDG&E) to include the coming winter season (November 1, 1986 through April 15, 1987), as well as the winter seasons established by the first Amendment to this agreement.

This Résolution will merely extend the agreement for one additional winter season. The agreement and the amendment with SDG&B which provides for increased gas pressures to meet the winter demand will remain the same in all other respects.

This filing will not increase any rate or charge, conflict with any rule or schedule nor cause the withdrawal of service.

This modification has been reviewed by the staff of the Service and Safety and Energy Branches of the Evaluation and Compliance Division and approval is recommended.

Public notification of this filing has been made by supplying copies of the filing to other utilities, governmental agencies, and to all interested parties who requested such notification. The Commission staff has received no protests in this matter.

We find this modification is just and reasonable and to be in the best interest of both SoCal Gas and SDC&B ratepayers.
