RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION AFFIRMING ADOPTION OF DECISION 99-05-051

BACKGROUND

At its May 27, 1999 meeting the Commission issued Decision (D.) 99-05-051 in Application (A.) 99-02-029, the application of San Diego Gas & Electric Company (SDG&E) for approval of proposed ratemaking and accounting which would end the utility's "transition period," established pursuant to AB 1890. At the time this decision was signed 2-0, the assigned Commissioner, Henry M. Duque, was necessarily absent and there were two vacancies on the Commission.

D.99-05-051 approved an uncontested settlement ending SDG&E's transition period, with certain conditions. The settlement terms subsequently became effective with notice from SDG&E that no party objected to the conditions set forth in D.99-05-051.

DISCUSSION:

1. The three Commissioners serving on May 27, 1999 wish to affirm the adoption of D. 99-05-051 at the May 27, 1999 Commission Meeting.
2. This Resolution was issued for public review and comment in accordance with Pub. Util. Code § 311(g). No comments were received.

ORDER


1. The Commission affirms the adoption of Decision 99-05-051 at the May 27, 1999 Commission Meeting.
