Resolution No. H-4743

(RESOLUTION ADOPTING LEVEL OF PUBLIC UTILITIES)
(COMMISSION UTILITIES REIMBURSEMENT ACCOUNT FEES)
(FOR FISCAL YEAR 1986-87)

Section 431 of the Public Utilities Code provides:

"The Commission shall annually determine a fee to be paid by every electrical, gas, telephone, telegraph, water, sewer system, and heat corporation and every other public utility providing service directly to customers or subscribers and subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission other than a railroad, except as provided in Article 2 (commencing with Section 421)."

The Commission finds that for fiscal year 1986-87 the Public Utilities Commission Utilities Reimbursement Account fees should be continued at the levels set for fiscal year 1985-86 as follows:

Electrical Corporations	.012¢/kWh
Gas & Heat Corporations	.068¢/therm
	1.4¢/thousand lbs steam
Telephone & Telegraph Corporations	1/10 of 1% revenue
Water & Sewer System Corporations	1.5% of Revenue

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

For the fiscal year 1986-87, the fees provided for in Section 431 of the Public Utilities Code are hereby fixed at the following levels subject to the approval of the Department of Finance:

Electrical Corporations	.012¢/kWh
Gas & Heat Corporations	.068¢/therm
	1.4¢/thousand lbs steam
Telephone & Telegraph Corporations	1/10 of 1% revenue
Water & Sewer System Corporations	1.5% of Revenue
