Resolution No. M-4777
June 21, 1995

(RESOLUTION CONTINUING 1994-95 LEVELS OF PUBLIC)
(UTILITIES COMMISSION UTILITIES REIMBURSEMENT)
(ACCOUNT FEES AFTER JUNE 30, 1995)

Section 431 of the Public Utilities Code provides:

"The Commission shall annually determine a fee to be paid by every electrical, gas, telephone, telegraph, water, sewer system, and heat corporation and every other public utility providing service directly to customers and subscribers and subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission other than a railroad, except as provided in Article 2 (commencing with Section 421)."

The Commission finds that until the Commission adopts fee levels for the Public Utilities Commission Utilities Reimbursement Account for the 1995-96 fiscal year, the fees adopted for this account in Resolution M-4770 for the 1994-95 fiscal year be continued in existence. Resolution M-4770 fixed these fees as follows:

Electrical Corporations	.012¢/kWh
Gas and Heat Corporations	.076¢/therm
	1.4¢/thousand lbs steam
Telephone and Telegraph Corporations	1/10 of 1% of revenue
Water and Sewer System Corporations	1.5% of revenue


IT IS ORDERED THAT:

The fees provided for in Section 431 of the Public Utilities Code are hereby continued at the following levels until the Commission adopts said fees for the 1995-96 fiscal year:

Electrical Corporations	.012¢/kWh
Gas and Heat Corporations	.076¢/therm
	1.4¢/thousand lbs steam
Telephone and Telegraph Corporations	1/10 of 1% of revenue
Water and Sewer System Corporations	1.5% of revenue

During this period the penalty provided for in Section 405 for default of the payment of the fee provided for in Section 431 shall remain fixed at 25% of the amount of the fee.
