R E S O L U T I O N

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING DESIGNATED EMPLOYEES IN THE CONSUMER SERVICES DIVISION AND IN THE RAIL SAFETY AND CARRIERS DIVISION TO EXERCISE POWERS OF PEACE OFFICERS WITHIN THE SCOPE OF THEIR DUTIES AS SPECIFIED BY PENAL CODE SECTION 830.11 AND PUBLIC UTILITIES CODE SECTION 308.5 AND APPOINTING THOSE EMPLOYEES AS PERSONS WHO MAY PERFORM SPECIFIC DUTIES DESCRIBED BY PUBLIC UTILITIES CODE SECTION 308

WHEREAS: The California Legislature, by Assembly Bill 2713, has, effective January 1, 1997, repealed Penal Code Section 830.7(e), and enacted Penal Code Section 830.11(a)(5), Public Utilities Code Section 308.5, and Public Utilities Code Section 5322; and

WHEREAS: The following named employees and supervisors of the Consumer Services Division have been designated pursuant to Penal Code Section 830.11 by Director William R. Schulte as persons having powers of peace officers; and

WHEREAS: The following named employees and supervisors of the Rail Safety and Carriers Division have been designated pursuant to Penal Code Section 830.11 by Director Kenneth L. Koss as persons having powers of peace officers; and

WHEREAS: The following named employees and supervisors, assigned to the Consumer Services Division and the Rail Safety and Carriers Division, have been previously designated and approved by the Commission as persons having powers of peace officers specified by Penal Code Section 830.7(e) and have previously, successfully completed the prescribed training course, pursuant to Penal Code Section 832, relating to exercising powers of arrest and search and seizure, and have successfully completed background examinations as required by Government Code Section 1031:

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Pursuant to Penal Code Section 830.11(a)(5), these employees and supervisors, formerly assigned to the Safety and Enforcement Division, and currently assigned to its successor Divisions, the Consumer Services Division, and the Rail Safety and Carriers Division, are hereby approved and authorized to exercise the powers of arrest as specified in Penal Code Section 836, and the power to serve warrants as specified in Penal Code Sections 1523 and 1530 during the course and within the scope of their employment, as provided by Penal Code Section 830.11(a)(5) and Public Utilities Code Section 308.5.

2. Each of these twelve employees and supervisors of the Consumer Services Division is further hereby designated as an "authorized official" within the meaning of Public Utilities Code Section 5322(j).
3. These employees and supervisors are further hereby appointed as persons who may serve Commission related warrants and other process in any county or city and county of this state, pursuant to Public Utilities Code Section 308.
4. All previous resolutions approving employees of the former Transportation Division and former Safety and Enforcement Division as persons who may exercise powers of peace officers, as provided by the recently repealed Penal Code Section 830.7(e), are now inoperative and rescinded.

This resolution is effective today.
