RESOLUTION ADOPTING LEVEL OF PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION UTILITIES REIMBURSEMENT ACCOUNT FEES FOR FISCAL YEAR 1999-2000

Section 431 of the Public Utilities Code provides:

"The Commission shall annually determine a fee to be paid by every electrical, gas, telephone, telegraph, water, sewer system, and heat corporation and every other public utility providing service directly to customers and subscribers and subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission other than a railroad, except as provided in Article 2 (commencing with Section 421)."

The Commission finds that for fiscal year 1999-2000 the Public Utilities Commission Utilities Reimbursement Account fees should be fixed as follows:

Electrical Corporations Gas and Heat Corporations

Telephone & Telegraph Corporations Water & Sewer System Corporations .012¢/kWh .076¢/therm 1.4¢/thousand lbs steam 11/100 of 1% of revenue 1.4% of revenue

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

For the fiscal year 1999-2000, the fees provided for in Section 431 of the Public Utilities Code are hereby fixed at the following levels:

Electrical Corporations	.012¢/kWh
Gas & Heat Corporations	.076¢/therm
	1.4⊄/thousand lbs steam
Telephone & Telegraph Corporations	11/100 of 1% of revenue
Water & Sewer System Corporations	1.4% of revenue

For fiscal year 1999-2000 the penalty provided for in Section 405 for default of the payment of the fee provided for in Section 431 shall remain fixed at 25% of the amount of the fee.

To comply with Public Utilities Code Sec. 311(g), the Executive Division commenced publication of a Daily Calendar notice on June 8, 1999 that apprised the public of the availability of its draft of this resolution and solicited submission of comments by June 23, 1999. No comments were received.
