4. A public hearing is not necessary.


Conclusion of Law



In conformity with the findings and order made by the Commission in a resolution entered this day, Common Carrier Contract T-129,254-28 Amendment No. 1, is ordered cancelled and will not go into effect April 18, 1991.

Each common carrier contract filed must cite the source of the equivalent tariff rates(s) by tariff and item number(s) as required by Rule 7.1(b) of General Order 147-B. Iron Horse Equipment filed Common Carrier Contract Number T-129,254-28, Amendment No. 1, which appeared on the Commission's Transportation Calendar April 8, 1991. The contract amendment was suspended on April 11, 1991 for 30 days because it does not cite the source of the carrier's equivalent tariff rates, violating Decision 90-02-021.



In conformity with the findings and order made by the Commission in a resolution entered this day, Tariff CAL P.U.C. No. 3, 1st Revised Page 32, Item 605 is ordered cancelled and will not go into effect May 17, 1991.

Service Air Cargo, filed Tariff CAL P.U.C. No. 3, 1st Revised Page 32, Item 605, which appeared on the Commission's Transportation Calendar April 11, 1991. The rate filing was suspended on April 16, 1991 for 30 days. The rate filing fails to conform with Rule 5.4 of General Order 147-B requiring the specification of qualifying criteria for discounts so that the users of the tariff can determine the exact charges for any given shipment. The rate filing does not clearly specify the criteria dictating the application of the discount and terms contained in the filing are not defined to allow a precise determination of the charges to be assessed for a given shipment.
