
Conclusion of Law



In conformity with the findings and order made by the Commission in a resolution entered this day, Special Contract T-154,407-1499 with ICI Resins is ordered canceled and will not go into effect January 2, 1992.

Special contracts must include evidence of substantial shipper obligation in the contract. To meet this requirement the contract must either provide for the carrier to earn a minimum of \$1,000 per month for delivered transportation services, or the contract must call for substantial shipper obligations not normally provided under common carrier tariff rates by any carrier.

The contract was listed on the Commission's Daily Transportation Calendar on November 19, 1991 and was suspended on December 3, 1991 for 30 days. The contract was suspended because it did not include evidence of substantial shipper obligation as required by Rule 6.14 of General Order 147-C.



In conformity with the findings and order made by the Commission in a resolution entered this day, Transportation Management Services is ordered to cancel Tariff No. 1 by January 2, 1992.

Common carrier tariffs must include a title page complete with prescribed information and are required to be designated by a CA PUC number. In addition, a common carrier must participate in those tariffs it specifies as governing publications.

This filing was listed on the Commission's Daily Transportation Calendar on November 26, 1991 and was suspended on December 3, 1991 for 30 days. The tariff was suspended because it did not meet the requirements of Rule 5.1 of General Order 147-C.
