In conformity with the findings and order made by the Commission in a resolution entered this day, Truckload Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc. is ordered to cancel Class and Commodity Public Utility Agency Tariff, CA PUC 7 by February 8, 1992.

Tariff CAL PUC 7 applies to public utility agency as defined in General Order 156. The purpose of GO 156 is to implement PU Code Sections 8281-8285 which require the Commission to establish a procedure for gas, electric and telephone utilities with gross revenues exceeding \$25,000,000 to submit annual detailed and verifiable plans for increasing female and minority enterprises' procurement in all categories. The tariff rates can only be extended to shippers with gross revenues greater than 25 million. Hence, public utilities with gross revenues equal to or less than 25 million are disadvantaged.

PU Code Section 453 forbids any public utility, as to rates, charges, service, facilities, or in any other respect, the making or granting of preference or advantage to any corporation or person or subject any corporation or person to any prejudice or disadvantage. Decision 90-02-021, as modified by D.91-05-027 prohibits shipper specific tariff. The filing was listed on the Commission's Daily Transportation Calendar on January 2, 1992 and was suspended January 8, 1992.
