OCR 1 T. R. Dobell Transportation
Carrier lacked the requisite operating authority (Highway Common Carrier Certificate) to file Common Carrier Contract T-158,356-1.

OCR 2 <u>G. I. Trucking Co., Inc.</u>
Carrier failed to show evidence of substantial shipper obligations in Contract T-12,983-796 as required for a Special Contract.

OCR 3 <u>Simon Trucking, Inc.</u>
Tariff filing contains shipper specific provisions which are prohibited by Commission Decision 90-02-021.

OCR 4 <u>Di Salvo Trucking</u>
Tariff filing contains released valuation items and annotations which are contrary to California Civil Code Section 2174 and Commission Decisions 90-05-055 and 90-02-021.

OCR 5 Wollin Transport, Inc.
Carrier failed to show evidence of substantial shipper obligations in Contract T-165,113-3 as required for a Special Contract.

OCR 6 <u>Crescent Truck Lines, Inc.</u>
Carrier failed to show evidence of substantial shipper obligations in Contract T-154,407-2267.

OCR 7 Motor Cargo
Tariff filing does not cite the authority for its publication as required by Rule 5.1 of General Order 147-C.

In conformity with the findings and order made by the Commission in a resolution entered this day, Special Contract T-12,983-796 with Woodland Products is ordered canceled and will not go into effect August 16, 1992.

Special contracts must include evidence of substantial shipper obligation in the contract. To meet this requirement the contract must either provide for the carrier to earn a minimum of \$1,000 per month for delivered transportation services, or the contract must call for substantial shipper obligations not normally provided under common carrier tariff rates by any carrier. The carrier failed to provide in the contract evidence of substantial shipper obligations as required by Rule 3.17 of General Order 147-C. Furthermore, the contract contains ambiguities which do not allow a precise determination of the compensation to be received by the carrier.

Items 5050 and 5300 represent shipper specific or "write-in" type rates. The Commission decreed in Decision 90-02-021 that this type of provision is unduly discriminatory and contrary to PUC Code Sections 453 and the General Order 80 Series. The annotations contained in these items are not related to any characteristic or condition of the transportation itself.

In conformity with the findings and order made by this Commission, in a resolution entered this day, Di Salvo Trucking Company is ordered to cancel Items 320-7 and 320-9 (9th Revised Page 19, and 3rd Revised Page 21 of CA PUC 54, Tariff WMT 570-A) by August 28, 1992.

Items 320-7 and 320-9 detail discount plans that are dependent upon released valuation and bill of lading annotations. California Civil Code Section 2174 and Commission Decision 90-05-055 set forth the provisions of released valuation, with which the tariff filing does not comply. The Commission decreed in Decision 90-02-021 that bill of lading annotations are unduly discriminatory and contrary to PUC Code Sections 453 and the General Order 80 Series. The annotations contained in these items are not related to any characteristic or condition of the transportation itself and would not sufficiently apprise the reader/shipper of the limitations of liability.
