Carrier files an amendment to contract which has been canceled.

Carrier fails to show evidence of substantial shipper obligations in
Special Contract T-172,115-3.

OCR 6 L M & D Service

Carrier lacks the requisite operating authority (highway common
carrier certificate) to file common carrier contract.

OCR 7 P.S.T.

Carrier lacks requisite operating authority (highway common
certificate) necessary to file a common carrier contracts.

OCR 8 Highway Carriers Tariff Bureau
Rate bureau attempts to eliminate from participation in its tariffs a carrier whose name does not match its "T" number according to Commission records, revealing that said bureau and carrier failed to comply with Rule 7.4 of General Order 147-C when the name change took place.

OCR 9 Viking Freight System, Inc.
Carrier fails to show evidence of substantial shipper obligations in Special Contract T-84,649-4912.

OCR 10 Southwest Truck Service
The contract does not contain the effective and termination dates.

OCR 11 Merchants of California
Carrier fails to show evidence of substantial shipper obligations to Special Contract T-172,716-1065.

OCR 12 Viking Freight System, Inc.
The shipper named in Amendment 2 to Special Contract T-84,649-364 is different from the shipper named in original filing.

OCR 13 Controlled Transport System
Carrier lacks the requisite operating authority (highway common carrier permit) to file a special contract.

OCR 14 Crescent Truck Lines, Inc.
Carrier fails to show evidence of substantial shipper obligations to Special Contract T-154,407-2383.

OCR 15 Dependable Highway Express
Carrier lacks the requisite operating authority (highway contract carrier permit) to file a common carrier contract.

OCR 16 Western Parcel Express
Carrier fails to define geographic area, unit of measurement and commodities involved in transportation.

OCR 17 Palmore Trucking
The contract does not contain the effective and termination dates.

OCR 18 Simon Trucking, Inc.
Carrier attempts to limit liability through tariff filing.

OCR 19 Savage Industries, Inc.
Carrier uses an incorrect contract number and attempts to extend a contract that has expired in Special Contract T-152,1461.





In conformity with the findings and order made by this Commission, in a resolution entered this day, La-Mar Transportation, T-121,479, is ordered to cancel Item 2100 (3rd Revised Page 7-B) of Local Freight Tariff #1, CPUC 1, September 26, 1992.

Item 2100 details a discount plan that is dependent upon a bill of lading annotation and released valuations. The Commission decreed in Decision 90-02-021 that bill of lading annotations are unduly discriminatory and contrary to PUC Code Sections 453 and the General Order 80 Series. California Civil Code Section 2174 and Commission Decision 90-05-055 set forth the provisions of released valuation, with which the tariff filing does not comply. The annotation is not related to any characteristic or condition of the transportation itself and would not sufficiently apprise the reader/shipper of the limitations of liability.

This filing was listed on the Commission's Daily Transportation Calendar on August 24, 1992, and was suspended for 30 days effective August 27, 1992.



In conformity with the findings and order made by this Commission, in a resolution entered this day, Industrial Freight System, Inc., T-67,620, is ordered to cancel the items and sections listed in Attachment A from Tariff 204, CA PUC 4, by September 26, 1992.

These items detail discount plans that are dependent upon bill of lading annotations. Furthermore, three items, 2117, 2166 and 2732, are further dependent upon released valuations. The Commission decreed in Decision 90-02-021 that bill of lading annotations are unduly discriminatory and contrary to PUC Code Sections 453 and the General Order 80 Series. California Civil Code Section 2174 and Commission Decision 90-05-055 set forth the provisions of released valuation, with which the tariff filing does not comply. The annotations contained in all of these items are not related to any characteristic or condition of the transportation itself and, in the case of the three released value provisions, would not sufficiently apprise the reader/shipper of the limitations of liability.
