RESOLUTION NO. OCR-1055 ORDER CANCELING COMMON CARRIER TARIFFS,  
COMMON CARRIER CONTRACTS, AND SPECIAL CONTRACTS WHICH HAVE BEEN  
TEMPORARILY SUSPENDED FOR VIOLATIONS OF D.90-02-021

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The common carrier tariffs, common carrier contracts, and special contracts listed below violate Commission Decision (D.) 90-02-021 and have been suspended. These rate filings have not been amended or corrected and will go into effect at the end of the suspension period, unless the Commission orders these rate filings to be canceled.



California Civil Code Section 2174 and Commission Decision 90-05-055 set forth the provisions of released valuation, with which the tariff filing does not comply. The annotation provisions in this item provide for automatic released valuation should the shipper fail to declare a value below \$25.00 per pound, and do not allow a shipper to declare the value of the goods to be higher than \$25.00 per pound and still receive the same transportation services.
