R E S O L U T I O N

RESOLUTION EXTENDING REINSTATEMENT PERIOD OF  
 SUSPENDED OR REVOKED PASSENGER STAGE CORPORATIONS  
 AND CHARTER-PARTY CARRIERS OF PASSENGERS FROM  
 SIXTY TO NINETY DAYS

WHEREAS: Commission Resolution PE-498 authorized the Executive Director to suspend or revoke the operating authority of passenger stage corporations and charter-party carriers of passengers which failed to have on file with the Commission evidence of current liability insurance in the amounts and formats prescribed by the Commission; and

WHEREAS: Commission Resolution PE-498 also authorized the Executive Director to reinstate such suspended or revoked operating authorities upon written request by the carrier if received by the Commission no later than 60 days from the effective date of suspension or revocation; and


WHEREAS there now exists a condition in the insurance industry which may make it difficult for a carrier to obtain the required liability insurance within this 60-day period;

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Executive Director may reinstate operating authorities which have been suspended or revoked pursuant to Commission Resolution PE-498, upon written request by the carrier received no later than 90 days from the effective date of suspension or revocation, and provided that the carrier has fully cured the failure giving rise to the revocation and paid a reinstatement fee of \$50.00.

This resolution is effective today.
