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RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION GRANTING VOLUNTARY SUSPENSION OF PASSENGER STAGE CORPORATION CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY HELD BY GAZOSA II CORPORATION DBA CAPITOL LINOUSINE AND CAPITOL AIRPORT SERVICE, PSC-1004

Gazosa II Corporation, doing business as Capitol Limousine and Capitol Airport Service, PSC-1004, by the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by the Decision 85-10-065 (Application 85-06-021) is authorized to transport passengers and their baggage between points in San Diego, Orange and Los Angeles Counties and certain intermediate and adjacent territories over and along the routes described in the above decision signed on October 17, 1985.

On April 10, 1986, Gazósa II Córporation requested voluntary suspension of PSC-1004 until May 7, 1987 because of substantial increases in operating expenses and the cost of maintaining the required insurance.

In these circumstances, the Commission finds that public convenience and necessity do not require the service of this carrier at this time.

IT IS ORDERED that:

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- The certificate of public convenience and necessity as a passenger stage corporation (PSC-1004) which was acquired by Gazosa II Corporation doing business as Capitol Limousine and Capitol Airport Service, pursuant to Decision 85-10-065, dated October 17, 1985 in Application 85-06-021, is hereby suspended until May 7, 1987.
- 2. Gazosa II Corporation is directed and authorized to file suspension supplements to the tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission.

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- 3. Prior to the resumption of service, tariff and timetable supplements cancelling the suspension supplements shall be filed. The required filings shall be made on not less than five days' notice to the public and to the Commission.
- 4. The authority to suspend operations granted herein shall expire on May 7, 1987 or upon earlier resumption of service, which may be effected upon compliance with ordering Paragraph 3 above.
- 5. Gazosa II Corporation is placed on notice that commencement of operations under the certificate referred to herein prior to compliance with Ordering Paragraphs 3 and 4 may be cause for further suspension or revocation of its operating authority.
