RESOLUTION GRANTING MARIN AIRPORTER ROUTE REVISION DOCKET
REQUEST FOR AN ADDITIONAL SERVICE POINT AT THE TRAVELODGE
IN NOVATO.

Marin Airporter has filed a request with the Commission pursuant to the Commission's Route Revision Docket procedure for the revision of passenger stage routes:

Marin Airporter is a passenger stage corporation authorized to transport passengers and their baggage between points in Marin County, San Francisco International Airport, and the Downtown Airline Terminal.

This request seeks to add an additional passenger pickup and discharge point at the Novato Travelodge at 7600 Redwood Highway, adjacent to the San Marin Exit to Highway 101. The new service point would relieve congestion at some of the other stops and would give Novato passengers an additional choice of pickup and discharge points.

Notice of this request appeared in the Commission's Transportation Calendar. No protests were received.

The Commission has considered the request and finds that the following is justified and is hereby granted:

SECTION 1. GENERAL AUTHORIZATIONS, RESTRICTIONS, LIMITATIONS, AND SPECIFICATIONS

Marin Airporter, a Corporation, by the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by the decision noted in the margin, is authorized to transport passengers and their baggage between Larkspur Landing Circle and Victoria Way, Larkspur; *The Travelodge, 7600 Redwood Highway, Novato; Denny's Restaurant, 7330 Redwood Highway, Novato; The Alvarado Inn Hotel, Novato; the Holiday Inn, aka Clarion Hotel, Northgate Drive, San Rafael; bus stops located on each side of Highway 101 at the interchange north of the Richardson Bay Bridge (serving Redwood Highway and Seminary Drive), Marin County (near Mill Valley); bus stops adjacent to Highway 101 at the interchange serving Highway 1, south of Richardson Bay Bridge, Marin County (near Sausalito), and Monte Mar and Spencer Streets, Sausalito; on the one hand, and the San Francisco International Airport or the Downtown Airline Terminal Building, Ellis and Taylor Streets, San Francisco, on the other hand, over and along the routes hereinafter described, subject to the authority of this Commission to change or modify said routes at any time and subject to the following provisions:

- (a) Motor vehicles may be turned at termini and intermediate points, in either direction, at intersections of streets or by operating around a block contiguous to such intersections, in accordance with local traffic regulations.
- (b) When route descriptions are given in one direction, they apply to operation in either direction unless otherwise indicated.
- (c) The service to the Downtown Airline Terminal in San Francisco shall be on an "on-call" basis for which a minimum of four (4) hours' notice is necessary.
- (d) No passenger(s) shall be picked up or discharged at any point intermediate thereto.

Via any and all routes between Larkspur Landing Circle and Victoria Way, Larkspur; *The Travelodge 7600 Redwood Highway, Novato; Denny's Restaurant, 7330 Redwood Highway, Novato; The Alvarado Inn Hotel, Novato; the Holiday Inn, aka Clarion Hotel, Northgate Drive, San Rafael; bus stops located on each side of Highway 101 at the interchange north of the Richardson Bay Bridge (serving Redwood Highway and Seminary Drive), Marin County (near Mill Valley); bus stops adjacent to Highway 101 at the interchange serving Highway 1, south of Richardson Bay Bridge, Marin County (near Sausalito); and Monte Mar and Spencer Streets, Sausalito; on the one hand, and the Downtown Airline Terminal Building, Ellis and Taylor Streets, San Francisco, on the other hand.
