RESOLUTION GRANTING VOLUNTARY SUSPENSION OF PASSENGER
STAGE CORPORATION CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE
AND NECESSITY HELD BY FOSTER'S TRANSPORTATION SERVICES,
INC., PSC-7.

Foster's Transportation Services, Inc. (Foster's) holds a certificate of public convenience and necessity as a passenger stage corporation (PSC-7) for the transportation of passengers and their baggage, and express, between Taft and Bakersfield and Taft and Santa Maria.

On January 27, 1988 Foster's requested voluntary suspension of PSC-7. The carrier could not continue to operate after it lost a subsidy from the City of Taft. Taft Area Transit, a city-operated public transportation system, took over the passenger transportation service formerly supplied by Foster's.

Under the circumstances, the Commission finds that public convenience and necessity do not require the service of this carrier at this time.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to Foster's Transportations Services, Inc. is hereby suspended for the period of one year commencing on the effective date of this resolution.
2. Foster's is authorized and directed to file suspension supplements to the tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission.
3. Prior to the resumption of service, tariff and timetable supplements cancelling the suspension supplements shall be filed. The required filing shall be made on not less than five days' notice to the public and to the Commission.

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4. The authority to suspend operations granted herein shall expire one year from the effective date of this resolution or upon earlier resumption of service, which may be accomplished through compliance with Ordering Paragraph 3 above.
5. Foster's is placed on notice that commencement of operations under the certificate that is the subject of this resolution without complying with Ordering Paragraphs 3 and 4 may cause further suspension or revocation on their operating authority.
