RESOLUTION REINSTATING PASSENGER STAGE CORPORATION CERTIFICATE
OF WILLIAM HUNT DBA HUNT'S TRANSPORTATION, PSC-1029

William Hunt dba Hunt's Transportation by the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by the Commission's Decision D-88159 in application A-57059 dated November 29, 1977 was authorized to operate as a passenger stage corporation to transport passengers between certain points in Orange County and Los Angeles County. This is a home-to-work operation.

By Resolution PE-2052 the Commission ordered the authority granted to William Hunt to operate as a passenger stage corporation be revoked for non payment of PUCTRA fees.

By letter dated February 26, 1988 Hunt supplied to the Commission staff copies of canceled checks showing that the PUCTRA fees had been paid with penalty and that all other PUCTRA fees have been paid in a timely matter. Evidence of insurance has been filed.

The Commission staff has received a petition dated March 17, 1988 asking that the service be continued. It was signed by 36 individuals who said they need the service to go to work. If the carrier is prevented from serving its routes because of its lack of Commission authority there will be extreme hardship on the public who rely on the service for transportation to work and contribute additional highway congestion and pollution. This reinstatement of authority should be granted immediately because of the public need for the service.

Under the circumstances the Commission finds that public convenience and necessity are best served if the Commission vacates the revocation resolution PE-2052 and reinstates the carrier's revoked operating authority described above.

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IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Resolution PB-2052 is rescinded.
2. The authority (PSC-1029) granted to William Hunt dba Hunt's Transportation is hereby reinstated.
3. Reinstatement of this authority may be made on the effective date of this resolution if a reinstatement fee of \$50.00 is paid to the Commission.
