RESOLUTION REVOKING THE VESSEL COMMON CARRIER CERTIFICATE OF  
H. TOURIST, INC. FOR THE TRANSPORTATION OF PASSENGERS BETWEEN  
SAN DIEGO AND AVALON ON CATALINA ISLAND.

H. Tourist, Inc. (Tourist) holds a certificate as a vessel common carrier (VCC-46) to transport passengers and their baggage between Los Angeles/Long Beach harbors, on the one hand, and points on Santa Catalina Island, on the other hand. Decision 87-02-025 in Application 86-09-017 granted Tourist the additional authority to provide service between San Diego, on the one hand, and Long Beach and Avalon on Santa Catalina Island, on the other hand. Decision 87-07-075 extended the time for Tourist to establish service until June 1, 1988.

On May 16, 1988 Edward J. Hegarty, attorney for Tourist, wrote to William R. Schulte of the Commission's Transportation Division staff. This letter states, in part, as follows: "Upon consideration of the fact that the San Diego-Avalon route is now being served by another vessel carrier and H. Tourist, Inc. does not presently operate a high-speed vessel in Southern California which is suitable to provide the service, the service will not be instituted and the certificate granted by Decision 87-02-025 should be revoked." In view of the foregoing, and since the last date to establish service set by Decision 87-07-075 has passed, revocation of this operating authority is appropriate.

IT IS ORDERED that the authority granted to H. Tourist, Inc. by Decision 87-02-025 to transport passengers by vessel between San Diego, on the one hand, and Long Beach harbor and the City of Avalon on Santa Catalina Island, on the other hand, is hereby revoked.
