REVOCATION OF PASSENGER STAGE CORPORATION CERTIFICATE OF
WESTERN STAGE LINES, INC. DBA EAGLE LINES, PSC-1384.

The carrier named above was granted by the Commission's Decision 85-04-040 (Application 84-11-032) signed April 3, 1985 a certificate of public convenience and necessity to transport passengers between points in the City of Los Angeles, the City of Rancho Palos Verdes, the City of Palos Verdes Estates, the City of Torrance, the City of Redondo Beach, the City of Hermosa Beach, the City of Lomita, the City of Rolling Hills Estates and the County of Los Angeles.

A recent written correspondence from the carrier was received by this Commission requesting that its certificate be revoked due to lack of patronage and that the carrier is experiencing substantial monetary loss.

Under the above circumstances the Commission finds that public convenience and necessity are best served if the carriers operating authority as a passenger stage corporation be revoked.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The authority granted to Western Stage Lines, Inc. dba Eagle Lines to operate as a passenger stage corporation is hereby revoked.
2. All current tariff and timetable filed by this carrier are cancelled.
