



R. S. Greitz, Tariff Issuing Officer, for and acting on behalf of MATHESON FAST FREIGHT, INC. (MFAF) (Applicant) does hereby apply under Sections 454, 460 and 491 of the Public Utilities Code for authority to make the following publication on not less than 5 days' notice.

TARIFF: Pacific Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., Agent, Tariff 550, CAL PUC No. 1.

PROPOSED: To cancel certain ^{Provisions} portions, (NMFC numbers along with their corresponding code numbers) of its portion of Item 2000 herein from the points of Auburn, Fresno, Menlo Park, Rancho Cordova, Sacramento, San Francisco, San Leandro, Stockton, Tracy and Visalia, and in lieu thereof to allow other provisions of the tariff to apply, as shown in Items 5 and 45 herein, and also Item 262 of the Governing Rules Tariff.

JUSTIFICATION

Applicant is a highway common carrier as authorized by Section 1063 and as such operates between points in the State of California.

Applicant respectfully seeks authority to cancel its participation in these items and to allow other provisions of the above tariffs to apply, since the charges in these specific Items are obsolete and there is no longer a movement of this traffic. The items proposed to be cancelled are minimum charges pertaining only to Item 262 of the Governing Rules Tariff and are discounts as well as increases to this carrier's minimum charges.

The minimum charges left to Matheson are the same as those the Commission has found reasonable as minimum for the same distances between other points in the State of California in the remainder of this tariff for other commodities.

Applicant respectfully submits that inasmuch as the changes sought herein would result in charges that the Commission has prescribed as minimum for the same distances in the tariff for other traffic the resulting charges will be just and reasonable as required by Section 451 of the Public Utilities Code. Furthermore, in those few instances where the resultant charges would be slightly higher than those applicable under other provisions of this tariff those charges are nevertheless within the zone of reasonableness, and therefore just and reasonable.

No shipper would suffer unduly by paying these higher charges. Many common carriers have authority within this area, advertise their services, and actively solicit this traffic. Moreover, Tariff 550 is a bureau tariff, participated in by approximately 169 carriers. In addition, there are other tariff Bureaus which publish rates and minimum charges, that apply within the same territories, and are participated in by hundreds of other common carriers and, therefore, would not be adversely affected by the granting of this application.

To the best of Applicant's knowledge, the cancellation of its participation in subject items would not result in any adverse effect on other carriers nor would said cancellations result in any preferential or prejudicial treatment of shippers who use its services.

Carrier requests that authority be granted under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to cancel its participation in Pacific Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., Tariff 550, Cal. P.U.C. No. 1, Item 2000 (Partial) as specified above, and requests that authority be granted under Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code in the event a technical violation of the Long and Short Haul Clause may exist.

Permission to make the cancellation on not less than 5 days' notice is requested since the rates are rarely used and early cancellation would benefit carrier in the area of fees and expenses in tariff maintenance and create an early elimination of a latent threat to carrier revenue.

The cancellation as requested herein, to the best of carrier's knowledge, will not result in an adverse effect on the quality of the human environment nor will it effect carrier's revenue to a greater extent.

The applicant hereby affirms that the proposal contained in this application is not a major action significantly affecting energy efficiency within the meaning of Section 3502.1 and 3502.2 of the Public Utilities Code.



An order is requested for the adoption of Supplement 1 to the ATA Hazardous Materials Tariff ATA 111-H and to make such provisions applicable to the

tariffs of highway common carriers and express corporations, which participate in and are listed in the HMT under authority of a power of attorney. It is further requested that such authorization be concurrent with the National effective date of June 6, 1987 and that it be granted on one day's notice; that all common carriers be authorized and directed to establish in their respective tariffs all such charges as may be prescribed and all orders made herein; that common carriers be authorized to establish such changes as may be prescribed in class and commodity rates and charges in connection with the transportation of exempt commodities; that common carriers be authorized to depart from Sections 460 and 461.5 of the Public Utilities Code and appropriate long and short haul provisions of the Constitution of the State of California to the extent necessary to carry into effect such changes; that any related revisions in numbering, referencing or format in the various tariffs, incidental to such changes, be authorized and established, and for such other and further orders as may be deemed reasonable and proper.


The Hazardous Materials Tariff is periodically revised in order to remain responsive to the current conditions and needs of commerce in the transportation of hazardous materials by highway carriers. The Hazardous Materials Tariff

Supplement 1, attached hereto as Exhibit A, and by this reference made a part hereof, proposes changes in the list of participating carriers and changes in the Hazardous Materials Regulations as ordered by the Department of Transportation and published in the Federal Register.

Supplement 1 to Hazardous Materials Tariff ATA 111-H with an issue date of May 1, 1987 and an effective date of June 6, 1987 also applies to tariffs covering areas other than California. The purpose of this filing is to obtain the authority necessary to make such provisions applicable to the tariffs of highway common carriers under jurisdiction of the Commission. Such authority will continue to promote national uniformity of regulations between interstate and intrastate traffic as well as between the states.

PART 171—GENERAL INFORMATION REGULATIONS, AND DEFINITIONS

In § 171.8 the definition of "residue" is revised to read as follows:

§ 171.8 Definition and Abbreviations.

"Residue" means the hazardous material remaining in a packaging, including a tank car, after its contents have been unloaded to the maximum extent practicable and before the packaging is either refilled or cleaned of hazardous material and purged to remove any hazardous vapors.

Paragraph (c) of § 171.12a is revised to read as follows:—

§ 171.12a Canadian shipments and packagings.
(c) Notwithstanding the requirements of Part 172 of this subchapter,

a hazardous material included in Division 3 or 4 of Class 2 of the TDG Regulations may be transported from its point of origin in the United States to Canada, or through the United States en route to a point in Canada, if—

- (1) The package is marked with the proper shipping name and identification number, and the freight container is marked, when appropriate, with the identification number, as required by the TDG Regulations;
- (2) The package is labeled, and the freight container, motor vehicle or rail car is placarded, as required by the TDG Regulations; and
- (3) The shipping paper contains an indication that these markings, labels and placards have been applied in conformance with this paragraph for the purpose of transport to Canada.

PART 172—HAZARDOUS MATERIALS PROGRAM PROCEDURES

In § 172.101, "Purpose and use of hazardous materials table", paragraph (i) is amended by redesignating (i)(6) to (i)(8) and adding (i)(5) to (i)(7) as follows:

(6) "4" means the material is authorized to be transported in only the limited quantities specified in the CFR section listed in column 5 and is subject to the stowage requirements specified for a cargo vessel for the same material.

(7) "5" means the material is forbidden and may not be offered or accepted for transportation.

(8) "6" means the material is authorized to be transported in a magazine subject to the requirements of §§ 176.135 through 176.141 of this subchapter.

In §172.102, "Purpose and use of Optional Hazardous Materials Table for International Shipments", paragraph (a)(1) is added to read as follows:

(a) * * *

(1) A shipping description and any associated entry which is listed in the current edition of the IMDG Code but is not listed in the Optional Table may be used as if it was listed in the Optional Table, if approved by the Director, OHMI.

In §172.334, "Identification numbers; prohibited display", paragraph (c) is revised as follows:

(c) Except as required by §172.332(c)(4) for a combustible liquid, the identification number of a material may be displayed only on the placards required by the tables in §172.504.

In §172.445, the Magnetized Material placard is deleted.

In §172.504, "General placarding requirements", Footnote 4 to Table 2 is revised to read as follows:

Table 2 * * *

* A FLAMMABLE placard may be used on a cargo tank or portable tank during transportation by highway, rail or water, and on a compartmented tank car containing materials classed as flammable liquid and combustible liquid.

In §172.510, "Special placarding provisions: Rail", paragraph (c)(1) is removed and paragraphs (c)(2) and (c)(3) are redesignated as (c)(1) and (c)(2) and read as follows:

(c) * * *

(1) is relocated with a material requiring no placards or different placards; or
(2) is sufficiently cleaned of residue and purged of vapor to remove any potential hazard.

In §172.525, "Standard requirements for the RESIDUE placard", paragraph (a) is revised to read as follows:

(a) Each RESIDUE placard must be as follows:

(1) Except as provided in paragraph (a)(3) of this section, the lower triangle of the RESIDUE placard must be black and the word "RESIDUE" must be in white letters approximately 1 inch (25 mm) high, made with approximately 1/4 inch (6 mm) stroke. Use of RESIDUE placards displaying the word "RESIDUE" in 1 1/2 inch lettering is authorized until July 1, 1987.

(2) Except for the POISON GAS, RADIOACTIVE, EXPLOSIVES, or subsidiary placard required by §172.505, the RESIDUE placard may be used to display the appropriate identification number in accordance with the provisions of Subpart D of this part.

(3) For a combustible liquid residue, the lower triangle of the RESIDUE placard must be white and the word "RESIDUE" must be in black letters.

(4) Otherwise, the RESIDUE placard must be as specified in §§ 172.519 and Appendix B to this Part, and §§ 172.528, 172.530, 172.532, 172.536, 172.540, 172.542, 172.544, 172.546, 172.548, 172.550, 172.552, 172.554 and 172.558, as appropriate for the residue of the hazardous material being transported and required by this subchapter to be placarded. No other placard may be used as a RESIDUE placard.

In § 172.525, "Standard requirements for the RESIDUE placard", paragraph (b) is revised by deleting the EMPTY FLAMMABLE placard and adding the RESIDUE placard.



In Part 172, Paragraph (c)(10) of Appendix B is amended by changing the reference to the size of the letters in the word "RESIDUE" in the placard from 1½ inches (40mm) to 1 inch (25mm).

PART 173—SHIPPERS—GENERAL REQUIREMENTS FOR SHIPMENTS AND PACKAGINGS

In § 173.4, "Exceptions for small quantities", paragraph (a)(1)(i) is amended by correcting the word "fluids" to "liquids".

In § 173.266, "Hydrogen peroxide solution in water," paragraph (f)(1) is amended by changing the last sentence in parenthesis to read: "(See §§ 173.31(a)(4) and 179.3(a) for additional requirements)."

PART 174—CARRIAGE BY RAIL

In § 174.25, "Additional information on waybills, switching orders and other billings", the last entry in the table which follows paragraph (a)(2)(ii) is removed, the following two entries are added to the end of the table, and paragraph (c) is revised to read as follows:

(a) * * *

(c) The shipping paper for a tank car that contains only the residue of a hazardous material must contain the words "RESIDUE: Last Contained" followed by the basic description of the hazardous material last contained in the tank car and the placard notation specified in the second column of the table in paragraph (a)(2) of this section followed by the word "RESIDUE". For example, "RESIDUE: Last Contained Petroleum Naptha, Combustible liquid, UN 1255, Placarded: COMBUSTIBLE—RESIDUE". For a tank car that contains a residue that is a hazardous substance, the letters "RD" must also be entered on the shipping paper either before or after the basic description.

Section 174.93, "Position in train of a tank car displaying RESIDUE placards", is revised to read as follows:

Except for a tank car placarded COMBUSTIBLE—RESIDUE, a tank car displaying RESIDUE placards in a moving or standing train may not be placed nearer than the second car from an engine or occupied caboose.

PART 177—CARRIAGE BY PUBLIC HIGHWAY

In § 177.817, "Shipping papers", paragraph (d) is revised to read as follows:

(d) This section does not apply to any material, other than a hazardous substance or a hazardous waste, that is classed as an ORM—A, B, C, or D. (See § 172.200 of this subchapter.)
