

R. S. Greitz, Tariff Issuing Officer, for and acting on behalf of Inter-Cal Contract Carriers, Inc. (ICAC) (Applicant) does hereby apply under Sections 454, 460 and 491 of the Public Utilities Code for authority to make the following publication on not less than 5 days' notice.

TARIFF: Pacific Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., Agent, Tariff 250, CAL PUC No. 3.

PROPOSED:

Authorization is requested to allow ICAC to be allowed to adopt, establish as its own, and be made a party to, the rates and rules of the tariff issues of Pacific Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc. (hereinafter referred to as PMTB), as follows:

Commodity Rate Tariff 250, CA PUC 3; including generally applicable common carrier rates in Items 3030, 3040, 3050, 3215 and others therein.

RESULTS: In a reduction of charges.

JUSTIFICATION

Applicant is a highway common carrier as authorized by Section 1053.5 and as such operates between points in the State of California.

ICAC by its Adoption Notice No. 1, effective January 24, 1986, adopted tariffs of Independent Contract Carriers (IDCT) of Sacramento, California (Cal. T-120,080) issued by Pacific Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., Tariff numbers PMTB 100, CAL PUC No. 4; PMTB No. 125, CAL PUC No. 2; PMTB No. 150, CAL PUC No. 4; and PMTB No. 551, CAL PUC No. 7, ICAC has now transferred provisions of Tariff PMTB 551 CAL PUC No. 7 to Tariff PMTB 550 CAL PUC No. 1, effective April 19, 1987. These tariffs, however, are limited in their scope, in that, they only cover a portion of the Rates (Class Rates and Exceptions to the Class Rates) authorized in ICAC's certificate. ICAC now finds itself without certain commodity rates and needs to adopt rates named above.

ICAC believes the most expeditious means of correcting this defect is to participate in additional Bureau tariffs.

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PUBLIC UTILITIES COMM.
STATE OF CALIF.
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Applicant respectfully submits that inasmuch as the changes sought herein would result in charges that the Commission has prescribed as generally applicable common carrier rates for the same distances in the tariff for other traffic the resulting charges will be just and reasonable as required by Section 451 of the Public Utilities Code.

No shipper would suffer by the adoption of this tariff. Many common carriers have authority within this area, advertise their services, and actively solicit this traffic. Moreover, Tariff 250 is a bureau tariff, participated in by approximately 169 carriers. In addition, there are other tariff Bureaus which publish rates and charges, that apply within the same territories, and are participated in by hundreds of other common carriers and, therefore, would not be adversely affected by the granting of this application.

To the best of Applicant's knowledge, the participation in subject tariff would result in no adverse effect on other carriers nor would said participation result in any preferential or prejudicial treatment of shippers who use its services.

Carrier requests that authority be granted under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to allow its participation to be published in Pacific Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., Tariff 250, Cal. P.U.C. No. 3, as specified above, and requests that authority be granted under Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code in the event a technical violation of the Long and Short Haul Clause may exist.

The participation as requested herein, to the best of carrier's knowledge, will not result in an adverse effect on the quality of the human environment.

The applicant hereby affirms that the proposal contained in this application is not a major action significantly affecting energy efficiency within the meaning of Section 3502.1 and 3502.2 of the Public Utilities Code.
