

An order is requested for the adoption of Supplement 2 to the ATA
Hazardous Materials Tariff ATA 111-H and to make such provisions applicable to the

tariffs of highway common carriers and express corporations, which participate in and are listed in the HMT under authority of a power of attorney. It is further requested that such authorization be concurrent with the National effective date of Dec. 26, 1987 and that it be granted on one day's notice; that all common carriers be authorized and directed to establish in their respective tariffs all such charges as may be prescribed and all orders made herein; that common carriers be authorized to establish such changes as may be prescribed in class and commodity rates and charges in connection with the transportation of exempt commodities; that common carriers be authorized to depart from Sections 460 and 461.5 of the Public Utilities Code and appropriate long and short haul provisions of the Constitution of the State of California to the extent necessary to carry into effect such changes; that any related revisions in numbering, referencing or format in the various tariffs, incidental to such changes, be authorized and established, and for such other and further orders as may be deemed reasonable and proper.

Highway common carriers and express corporations are operating as common carriers pursuant to the authority of this Commission and in accordance with tariffs filed with this Commission, which tariffs are subject to and governed by the ATA Hazardous Materials Tariff ATA 111-H, Cal PUC 18 and supplements, thereto.


The Hazardous Materials Tariff is periodically revised in order to remain responsive to the current conditions and needs of commerce in the transportation of hazardous materials by highway carriers. The Hazardous Materials Tariff

is also periodically reissued to minimize the difficulties which accompany excessive supplementation of tariff material.

Supplement 2, attached hereto as Exhibit A, and by this reference made a part hereof, proposes changes in the list of participating carriers and changes in the Hazardous Materials Regulations as ordered by the Department of Transportation and published in the Federal Register.

Supplement 2 to Hazardous Materials Tariff ATA 111-H with an issue date of November 20, 1987 and an effective date of December 26, 1987 also applies to tariffs covering areas other than California. The purpose of this filing is to obtain the authority necessary to make such provisions applicable to the tariffs of highway common carriers under jurisdiction of the Commission. Such authority will continue to promote national uniformity of regulations between interstate and intrastate traffic as well as between the states.

In §171.8, the definitions for "Hazardous material" and "Hazardous substances" are revised to read as follows:

§171.8 Definitions and abbreviations.

"Hazardous material" means a substance or material, including a hazardous substance, which has been determined by the Secretary of Transportation to be capable of posing an unreasonable risk to health,

safety, and property when transported in commerce, and which has been so designated.

"Hazardous substance", for the purposes of this subchapter, means a material, including its mixtures and solutions, that—

- (1) Is listed in the Appendix to § 172.101 of this subchapter;
- (2) Is in a quantity, in one package, which equals or exceeds the reportable quantity (RQ) listed in the Appendix to § 172.101 of this subchapter, and
- (3) When in a mixture or solution, is in a concentration by weight which equals or exceeds the concentration corresponding to the RQ of the material, as shown in the following table:

In § 171.11 paragraph (d)(1)(i) is revised to read as follows:

§ 171.11 Use of ICAO Technical Instructions.

(3) ***

- (1) The name of the hazardous substance shall be entered on shipping papers in parentheses in association with the basic description, and in association with the proper shipping names required to be marked on the package, unless the proper shipping name required by the ICAO Technical Instructions already includes the name of the hazardous substance. For waste streams or for wastes which exhibit an EPA characteristic of ignitability, corrosivity, reactivity, or EP toxicity, the basic description shall be followed by the waste stream number in parentheses or by the letters "EPA" and the word "ignitability" or "corrosivity" or "reactivity", or "EP toxicity", in parentheses, as appropriate; and

In § 171.11, paragraph (d)(9) is added to read as follows:

§ 171.11 Use of ICAO Technical Instructions.

(d) ***

(9) When a hazardous material, which is subject to the requirements of the ICAO Technical Instructions, falls within the inhalation hazard criteria described in § 173.3(a)(2):

- (i) The shipping description must include the words "Poison-Inhalation Hazard", except that only the word "Poison" is required when the material is shipped in a combination packaging with inner packagings containing one liter or less;
- (ii) The material must be packaged in accordance with the requirements of § 173.3; and,
- (iii) The package must be marked and labelled in accordance with the requirements of §§ 172.301(a) and 172.402(a)(10).

In § 171.12a, paragraph (a)(3)(i) is revised to read as follows:

§ 171.12a Canadian shipments and packagings.

(a) ***
(3) ***

- (1) The name of the hazardous substance shall be entered on shipping papers and in association with the proper shipping name required to be marked on the package, in parentheses, unless the proper shipping name required by the TDG regulations already includes the name of the hazardous substance. For waste streams or for wastes which exhibit an EPA characteristic of ignitability, corrosivity, reactivity, or EP toxicity, the basic description shall be followed by the waste stream number in parentheses or by the letters "EPA" and the word "ignitability" or "corrosivity" or "reactivity", or "EP toxicity", in parentheses, as appropriate; and

PART 172—HAZARDOUS MATERIALS TABLES AND HAZARDOUS MATERIALS COMMUNICATIONS REGULATIONS

In § 172.101, paragraphs (b) and (c)(9) are revised to read as follows:

§ 172.101 Purpose and use of hazardous materials table.

(b) Column 1 contains the three symbols as appropriate: Plus (+) and the letters "A" and "W".

(1) The plus (+) fixes the proper shipping name and the hazard class for that entry without regard to whether the material meets the definition of that class. An alternate proper shipping name and hazard class may be authorized by the Director, Office of Hazardous Materials Transportation, RSPA.

(2) A letter "A" restricts the application of this subchapter to materials offered or intended for transportation by aircraft, unless the material is a hazardous substance or a hazardous waste.

(3) The letter "W" restricts the application of this subchapter to materials offered or intended for transportation by vessel, unless the material is a hazardous substance or a hazardous waste.

(c) ***

(9) Hazardous substance. The Appendix to this section lists materials which are listed or designated as hazardous substances under section 101(14) of the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA). Proper shipping names for hazardous substances (See Appendix and § 171.8 of this subchapter) shall be determined as follows:

- (i) If the hazardous substance appears in the table by technical name, then the technical name is the proper shipping name.
- (ii) If the hazardous substance does not appear in the table and is not a forbidden material (See §§ 173.21, 173.51, 183.66, and 173.114(a) of this subchapter), then an appropriate generic shipping name must be selected corresponding to the hazard class of the material as determined by the defining criteria of this subchapter and the hazard precedence prescribed in § 173.2 of this subchapter. For example, a hazardous substance which meets the definition of a flammable liquid might be described as "Flammable liquid, n.o.s." or other appropriate shipping name corresponding to the flammable liquid hazard class.

In the § 172.101 Hazardous Materials Table:

a. For the entry "Uranium hexafluoride, fissile (containing more than 1% U-235)," the column (5)(b) section reference is revised to read "173.417, 173.420."

b. For the entry "Uranium hexafluoride, low specific activity," the column (5)(a) section reference is revised to read "173.421-2."

c. For the entry "Uranium hexafluoride, low specific activity," the column (5)(b) section reference is revised to read "173.420, 173.425."

In § 172.101, the Hazardous Materials Table is amended as follows:

- a. "E" is removed from the heading of Column 1;
- b. The symbol "E" is removed from Column 1;
- c. All reportable quantity (RQ) designations and quantities are removed from the descriptions in Column 2 (e.g., "(RQ-1000/454))";
- d. The phrase "(these materials may contain various hazardous substances for which the appropriate RQ applies)" is removed from the Column 2 entry for "Motor fuel antiknock compound";
- e. All entries in the table that are class "ORM-E" as shown in Column 3 are removed from the table, except for the following two generic entries: "Hazardous substance, liquid or solid, n.o.s." and "Hazardous waste, liquid or solid, n.o.s.," and

f. The following five "See" references to certain materials classed ORM-E are removed from the table:

- (a) "2,4-D ester. See 2,4-Dichlorophenoxyacetic acid ester";
- (b) "EDTA. See Ethylenediaminetetraacetic acid";
- (c) "PCB. See Polychlorinated biphenyls";
- (d) "2,4,5-T amine, ester, or salt. See 2,4,5-Trichlorophenoxyacetic acid, amine, ester, or salt"; and
- (e) "2,4,5-TP ester. See 2,4,5-Trichlorophenoxypropionic acid ester".

In §172.102, paragraph (e) is revised to read as follows:

§172.102 Purpose and use of Optional Hazardous Materials Table for International shipments.

(e) If a hazardous material that is a hazardous substance is offered, accepted or transported under an acceptable shipping name from the Optional Table that does not contain the name of the hazardous substance, the name of the hazardous substance must be entered, in parentheses, in association with the proper shipping name. For waste streams or for wastes which exhibit an EPA characteristic of ignitability, corrosivity, reactivity, or EP toxicity, the basic description must be followed by the waste stream number in parentheses or by the letters "EPA" and the word "ignitability" or "corrosivity" or "reactivity", or "EP toxicity", in parentheses, as appropriate.

In §172.203, paragraph (c) is revised to read as follows:

§172.203 Additional description requirements.

(c) Hazardous substances.

(1) If the proper shipping name for a mixture or solution that is a hazardous substance does not identify the constituents making it a hazardous substance, the name or names of such hazardous substance constituents as shown in the Appendix to §172.101 must be entered in parentheses in association with the basic description. For waste streams or for wastes which exhibit an EPA characteristic of ignitability, corrosivity, reactivity, or EP toxicity, the basic description must be followed by the waste stream number in parentheses or by the letters "EPA" and the word "ignitability", or "corrosivity", or "reactivity", or "EP toxicity", in parentheses, as appropriate. These requirements also apply when descriptions from the Optional Table in §172.102 are used.

(2) The letters "RQ" must be entered on the shipping paper either before or after the basic description required by §172.202 for each hazardous substance. For example: "RQ, Cresol, Corrosive material, UN 2076, or Hazardous substance, liquid, n.o.s., ORM-E, NA 9188 (Adipic Acid), RQ".

In §172.203, "Additional description requirements," paragraph (e) is revised to read as follows:

(e) Empty packagings. (1) The description on the shipping paper for a packaging containing the residue of a hazardous material may include the words "RESIDUE: Last contained" *** in association with the basic description of the hazardous material last contained in the packaging.

(2) For a tank car containing the residue (as defined in 171.8) of a hazardous material, the requirements of §174.25(c) and paragraph (e)(3) of this section apply.

(3) If a packaging, including a tank car, contains a residue that is a hazardous substance, the description on the shipping papers must be prefaced with the phrase "RESIDUE: Last Contained" *** and the letters "RQ" must be entered on the shipping paper either before or after the basic description.

In §172.324 is revised to read as follows:

§172.324 Hazardous substances.

(a) Except as provided in paragraph (b) of this section, if the proper shipping name for a mixture or solution that is a hazardous substance does not identify the constituents making it a hazardous substance, the name or names of such hazardous substance constituents as shown in the Appendix to §172.101 must be marked in parentheses in association with the proper shipping name on each packaging having a capacity of 110 gallons or less. This requirement also applies when descriptions from the Optional Table in §172.102 are used.

(b) Those packages with a capacity of 110 gallons or less which contain waste streams or wastes which exhibit an EPA characteristic of ignitability, corrosivity, reactivity, or EP toxicity, must be marked in parentheses in association with the proper shipping name with the applicable waste stream number or the letters "EPA" and the word "ignitability", or "corrosivity", or "reactivity", or "EP toxicity" as appropriate.

(c) The letters "RQ" must be displayed in association with the proper shipping name on a packaging having a capacity of 110 gallons or less that contains a hazardous substance.

PART 173—SHIPPERS GENERAL REQUIREMENTS FOR SHIPMENTS AND PACKAGINGS

In §173.34(e), the introductory paragraph is corrected to read as follows:

§173.34 Qualification, maintenance and use of cylinders.

(e) Periodic retesting, reinspection and marking of cylinders. Each cylinder that becomes due for periodic retest as specified in the following table and exceptions, must be retested and marked in conformance with the applicable requirements of this paragraph. ***

A new §173.420 is added to read as follows:

§173.420 Uranium hexafluoride (fissile and low specific activity).

(a) In addition to any other applicable requirements of this chapter, uranium hexafluoride, fissile or low specific activity, shall be packaged in conformance with the following requirements:

(1) Before initial filling and during periodic inspection and test, packagings shall be cleaned in accordance with the specific procedures of Appendix A of American National Standard N14.1-1982.

(2) Packagings must be designed, fabricated, inspected, tested and marked in accordance with American National Standard N14.1-1982.

(3) Uranium hexafluoride must be in solid form when offered for transportation.

(4) The volume of the solid uranium hexafluoride at 70 F must not exceed 61% of the volumetric capacity of the packaging, and

(5) The pressure in the package at 70 F must be less than 14.8 psia.

(b) Packagings of uranium hexafluoride must be periodically inspected, tested and marked in accordance with American National Standard N14.1-1982.

(c) Each repair to a packaging for uranium hexafluoride shall be performed in conformance with American National Standard N14.1-1982.

§173.420(a)(2) is revised to read as follows:

§173.420 Uranium hexafluoride (fissile and low specific activity).

(a) ***

(2) After June 30, 1987, packagings must be designed, fabricated, and marked in accordance with American National Standard N14.1-1982, or a previous edition thereof.

PART 175—CARRIAGE BY AIRCRAFT

In §175.10, the introductory text to paragraph (a)(4) and paragraph (a)(15) are revised to read as follows:

§175.10 Exceptions

(a) ***

(4) Non-radioactive medicinal and toilet articles carried by a crew member or passenger in checked or carry-on baggage, and aerosols with no subsidiary risk, for sporting or home use, when carried in checked baggage only, when:

(15) Alcoholic beverages, perfumes, colognes, and liqueued gas lighters that have been examined by the Bureau of Explosives (B of E) and approved by the Director, Office of Hazardous Materials Transporta-

tion, carried aboard a passenger-carrying aircraft by the operator for use or sale on the aircraft.

In §175.30, in paragraph (e)(1)(ii) the period at the end of the sentence is revised to read " ; or" and paragraph (e)(1)(iii) is added to read as follows:

§175.30 Accepting and inspecting shipments.

(e) ***

(1) ***

(ii) Not more than one package is overpacked.
