

EXHIBIT "B"

JUSTIFICATION

The proposed amendment is based upon alternative application provisions as contained in the Commission's Minimum Rate Tariffs and authority was taken from Pacific Southeast Freight Bureau, Tariff No. 300-A, Item No. 18740 and PSFB Ex Parte Nos. 256 and 259-A. Applicant has been charging class rates in the past.

Authority is sought under Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code due to the divergence in routing between that employed by applicant and that employed by competing rail carriers. An example of where authority is necessary under Section 460 would be a shipment originating at Index No. 4506 Los Angeles and destined to Index No. 1 San Francisco. In all probability this shipment would move north via U. S. Highway 99, and west on U. S. Highway 50, passing through an intermediate point one mile south of San Francisco, which is not served by competing rail carriers. This would require applicant to charge class rates to this point which are higher than the rates proposed to be published. Therefore, authority is sought to depart from Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code in order that no so-called long-short haul violations exist. This is merely one example utilizing only one point of origin and one point of destination proposed to be published. Any number of examples could have been cited, utilizing all points of origin and all points of destination proposed to be published.

Authority is sought under Section 491 of the Public Utilities Code to publish the proposed changes on less than statutory notice for the reasons set forth above and in order that carriers may be competitive with permitted carriers who may charge the proposed rates at will.

EXHIBIT "A"

This application seeks authority to amend Item 367 applying from Port Hueneme, Cal. and other points grouped therewith to Madera, Cal. by changing the minimum weight in connection with rate of 45½ cents under Column 13 from (30) min wt 30,000 lbs. to circle (50) min wt 50,000 lbs. thereby restoring rate at former minimum weight.

Rate in question was formerly published in Item 366, 14th Revised Page 41A being 45 cents, subject to X-223 (see copy of page attached designated Exhibit "B"). However, in further amending this page which had to be made into two pages account of different increase to be applied under rates taking Columns 1 and 6 (making the page too long), the Madera rates were transferred to Item 367 Original Page 41AA (see copy of page attached designated Exhibit "C") and, in so doing, the printer inadvertently changed the circle (50) to a circle (30) thereby causing an unauthorized reduction in minimum weight.

One of the interested carriers have just discovered this error and have requested that this change be corrected as soon as possible; therefore, this application seeks authority under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to make this correction on statutory notice.



EXHIBIT "B"

JUSTIFICATION

Authority is sought under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to create increases by amending the above numbered item for the following reasons: By virtue of Cal. P.U.C. Decision No. 75365 dated February 25, 1969, Di Salvo Trucking Co. was granted authority to cancel rates on bulk grains and related articles from Tariff No. 111. Subject bulk rates on grain and related articles were cancelled subject to thirty (30) days' notice on 10th Revised Page 223-A with an effective date of April 23, 1969. Due to an inadvertent compiling error, bulk rates were re-inserted in the 10,000 and 20,000 lb. columns for the account of Di Salvo Trucking Co. on 12th Revised Page 223-A, scheduled to become effective on June 2, 1969. The provisions shown in Item 4712 for the account of Certified Freight Lines, Inc., will be transferred to Item Nos. 4718, 4719 and 4720 of the subject tariff. The restriction contained in the ⑤ reference and Note 3 will be cancelled, allowing the prevailing distance commodity rates in the above cited items to apply.

Authority is sought under Section 491 of the Public Utilities Code to publish the proposed changes on less than statutory notice in order to correct the compiling error and to allow the provisions contained in Cal. P.U.C. Decision No. 75365 to continue without interruption.
