RESOLUTION

ORDER AUTHORIZING CABLEVIEW COMMUNICATIONS, INC.
TO EXTEND FOR SIX MONTHS ITS EXPERIMENTAL INSTALLATION
OF FIBER GLASS ARMS TO SUPPORT COMMUNICATION CABLES AND
MESSENGERS ON WOOD POLES.

SUMMARY

1. By letter dated December 13, 1989, Pacific Bell requests on behalf of itself, Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E), California Cable Television Association (CCTA) and Cableview Communications, Inc. (Cableview), authorization to extend for a period of six months Cableview's experimental installation of fiber glass arms.

BACKGROUND

1. By Resolution SU-2 dated June 21, 1989, Cableview, in cooperation with CCTA, PG&B and Pacific Bell, was authorized to conduct a six month experimental installation of fiber glass arms to support communications cables and messengers on wood poles.

DISCUSSION

- 1. Due to technical and scheduling difficulties all the parties have agreed to remove, reinstall and re-evaluate some of the arms.
- 2. Bécause of the necessary changes, more time is néeded to re-evaluate the experimental installation.

PINDINGS

- 1. Pacific Bell's request on behalf of itself, PGEE, CCTA and Cableview has been reviewed by the Commission's Safety Division staff. The additional time should allow all parties sufficient time to evaluate the arms under conditions mutually agreed upon.
- 2. We find that Pacific Bell's request is reasonable. The findings in Resolution SU-2 remain as stated.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. An extension of time for the experimental installation is authorized to end six months from today.
- 2. With the exception of the added time, the provisions in Ordering Paragraphs 1 through 3 of Resolution SU-2 shall remain in effect.
- 3. This Resolution is effective today.
